



It's time to ride !!!

Basic Rules of Ridership:

Eating, drinking, and smoking are not permitted on board SCCOG Transit vehicles. Food and beverages may only be carried on board if securely closed in spill-proof containers.

Large Packages:

Large packages are not allowed on SCCOG Transit Vehicles. Generally, "large" is defined by two practical observations. First was the passenger able to easily carry the packages onto the vehicle in a single trip. Second is the passenger able to hold the items in their lap if necessary.

Weapons:

Weapons, including knives and firearms are not permitted on SCCOG Transit vehicles.

Loitering:

Passengers on SCCOG Transit vehicles and property must have a destination for their trip.

Hazardous Materials:

Items that contain potentially hazardous materials are NOT permitted on the bus. These items include gas cans, paint, fireworks, and car batteries.

Tobacco:

Smoking is not permitted on any SCCOG Transit vehicle.

Disorderly Conduct:

Profanity, vulgar language and disorderly conduct are not permitted on SCCOG Transit vehicles or property.

Pets:

Pets under owners control are allowed on SCCOG Transit Vehicles.
